Annex to the Statement on the Reproduction of Manuscripts

1. The Niedersächsische Staats- und Universitätsbibliothek Göttingen (SUB Göttingen) is committed to collecting research results relating to its manuscripts and personal archives. Any publication or scholarly work (including theses and dissertations), in any medium, based on or concerning the manuscripts and personal archives held by SUB Göttingen must be reported to the library. Where legally and contractually permissible, the library kindly requests the submission of the publication's structural and metadata.
2. The Library takes a great interest in receiving copies of its users' publications concerning its holdings in order to catalogue and archive them. This expressly includes publications in digital form as well as databases. New findings and research tools will contribute to the further study of its holdings and to benefit users of SUB Göttingen.
3. Photographic, digital, and other reproductions produced by SUB Göttingen may be used only for private, personal, and scholarly purposes (§§ 53, 60c UrhG). The consent of SUB Göttingen must be obtained prior to publishing such reproductions in printed form or on the internet or passing them on to third parties. Even after granting a permission for publication, SUB Göttingen reserves the right to publish the reproductions itself in any medium or to authorise third parties to do so.
4. Fees may be charged for the reproduction and the commercial use of photographic, digital, and other reproductions produced by SUB Göttingen. The determination of fees is based on the tax-related classification of the recipient of the service according to Section 2b (2) No. 2 of the German VAT Act (UStG) in conjunction with Section 4 No. 20a UStG.
5. In case of doubt, the German version of this statement of commitment shall prevail.
